

Graduate Requirements and Class Assisting

Any student wishing to graduate, receiving a diploma from Studio 84 School of Dance, must meet the following requirements:

- Students are required to have at least 3 years of student teaching. More than 3 years is encouraged! Students may begin assisting class as early as age 12, however at least 2 assisting years must occur from 10th-12th grade.
- Students must be enrolled in both combination and ballet class throughout high school.
- Seniors who have progressed to the Advanced II level will be allowed to participate in an optional graduate dance. Depending on the number of graduates, the number of students per dance may vary. This decision is solely the teacher's discretion. There will also be a \$300 choreography fee.

If you are interested in becoming a class assistant, we will have a **mandatory** Class Assistant Training Camp on Monday, August 20th from 4:00-7:00 at the studio. The cost is \$65. Training includes a CPR/First Aid course and a class assistant shirt. If you have not signed up for this training, please contact the office asap.
